EuroStruct emerged from COST Action TU146 “Quality specifications for roadway bridges, standardization at a European level (BridgeSpec)”, which aimed to achieve the European economic and societal needs by standardizing the condition assessment and maintenance level of roadway bridges.

With a duration of only 4 years, it was found that the work carried out during COST Action TU1406 could still be further developed and its purpose could be extended to structures other than road bridges. With this in mind, it was decided to create the EuroStruct Association which aims to promote the understanding and advancement of practice on quality control of bridges and structures at a European level.

Such desideratum can be achieved by:

- improving the quality of bridges and structures in Europe;
- promoting worldwide cooperation and understanding through the exchange of knowledge and experience in quality control;
- encouraging awareness and responsibility of structural engineers towards the needs of society;
- encouraging actions necessary for progress of quality control in bridges and structures;
- improving and fostering cooperation and understanding between organisations with similar objectives.

Dr. Vikram Pakrashi (BEng, PhD, CEng, MIEI, MASCE) is Associate Professor in Mechanical Engineering and Director of Dynamical Systems and Risk Laboratory (DSRL) in UCD. Vikram is a Chartered Engineer and has served both industry and academia working on numerical and experimental applications of dynamics and risk/probabilistic analysis on traditional (roads, bridges) and burgeoning (wind/wave energy devices and platforms) sectors of built infrastructure. Several of his projects are partly funded by the industrial sector. His recent research activities involve structural health monitoring, analysis of dynamic systems, vibration control, experimental methods in dynamics, damage detection algorithms and the use of new technologies for such applications. Vikram has supervised and mentored several doctoral and postdoctoral researchers and has received multiple awards for his research and leadership activities. He currently works with a dynamic and motivated team in DSRL close to industrial needs. Vikram is open for collaborations and participation in relevant funding calls.

Dr. Abdollah Malekjafarian received his PhD in Civil Engineering from University College Dublin in 2016. He is currently an Assistant Professor and leader of “Structural Dynamics and Assessment Laboratory (SDA-Lab)” in the school of Civil Engineering at UCD (<https://sdal.ucd.ie/>). His main areas of research interest are Structural Dynamics and Random Vibrations for Civil Infrastructure including "Transport Infrastructure" and "Offshore Wind Turbines". He is currently the Principal Investigator of Di-Rail project (<https://di-rail.ucd.ie/>), which is funded by Science Foundation Ireland, under the Frontiers for the Future call. He is also the Coordinator of WindLEDeRR project (<https://windlederr.ucd.ie/>), funded by Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland, under the RD&D call.

Abdollah is a member of the Young Academy of Ireland (YAI) selected by the Royal Irish Academy (RIA). He also received the "KB Broberg" medal in 2020 and Royal Irish Academy Charlemont award in 2018 for his outstanding contribution to his field of research. He is also a member of editorial boards of “Journal of Shock and Vibration” and “Journal of Vibroengineering”.

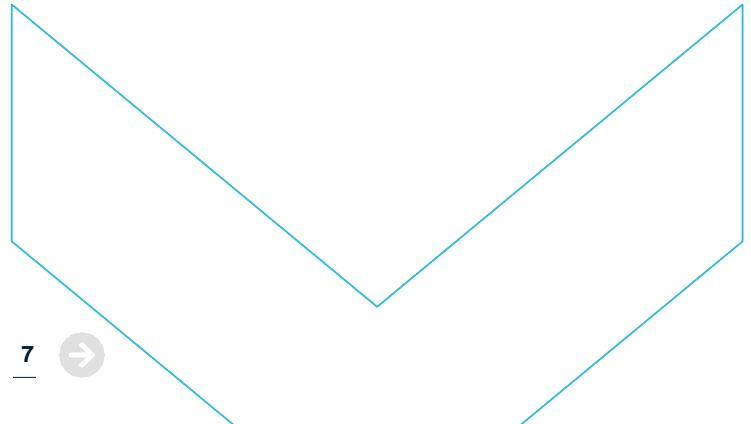
